Now I have a confession to make... When I recorded the 3rd part of "**Faith WITH Works... WORKS**" & "**The 5 Essential Elements Needed To Achieve ANY Goal**" I spoke on the subject of goal setting, as you will soon get to hear. Pardon me for stating the obvious, but here's my confession! Shortly after I finished recording the Spirit of God drew my attention to something...

I spoke about goals in very generic terms! I hadn't addressed goal setting and achieving in reference to spiritual issues... (Now you will also hear me talking about setting goals in terms of acquiring new skills and hobbies, in things you've always wanted to do!) But you know what, came to mind???

How about using your goals, to acquire new skills and hobbies as an opportunity for the advancement of God's Kingdom! Whether it be sharing your faith with those you meet in your new circle of friends Or using those newly acquired skills, for use in the actual work of His Kingdom!

In either case we should go to learn new things with those very intentions in mind! AS Believers EVERYthing we do must in some way contribute to the advancement of the Kingdom! Seek the Kingdom's agenda first in EVERY endeavour! When you do God promises whatsoever you do WILL prosper (Read Psalm chapter1)

When it comes down to it, you are to live for God, and do His Will! He made you and made salvation available to you, living for Him is the very least you could do! "Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." 1Corinthians10:31 And it's what you, I and every believer MUST do if we ever want to hear the Words, "Well done my good and faithful servant!!!"

So I've outlined **7 Spiritual Goals**, you as a believer in Christ must have, which pertain to the benefit of the Kingdom, you and I belong to!

#1 Draw closer to God

Of all your goals your #1 goal is to be like Jesus... Be LIKE Jesus, having his Character being the sovereign influence of your EVERY thought, feeling, word and deed! And you accomplish that by drawing near to God in Prayer and meditation of His Word...

God bestows upon us a rich measure of wisdom and grace, "When the mind of man is brought into communion with the mind of God, the finite with the Infinite, the effect on body and mind and soul is beyond estimate. In such communion is found the highest education. It is God's own method of development. "Acquaint now thyself with Him" (Job 22:21), is His message to mankind." (Acts of the Apostles p126)

#2 Preparing yourself for heaven.

Preparing others for heaven (You and I are responsible for bringing sinners out of darkness and leading them to Christ)

#3 Love God and prove this by living a life of obedience to Him
Love your neighbour as yourself.

#4 Die to self to do the Will of God

#5 Putting God's Kingdom first in everything, using your resources, i.e. time, energy and finance to further the work of the gospel! God's Kingdom is your #1 priority, everything you do must serve the Kingdoms agenda of advancement in this earth!

#6 You may recall when Jesus spoke about the widows offering, he spoke of it as having great significance, though small in intrinsic value it was immensely valuable in terms of the percentage of what she had it was 100%... Jesus is very much interested in your money, not that He's after it, He already owns it. But He is interested in how you handle the money he has given you! Why? Because He can gage your priorities by your financial priorities.

The Word of God says, "Where your treasure is there will your heart be also!" (Matthew6:21) "Money answers all things..." (Ecclesiastes10:19)!

So with that said, it's a good idea to set financial goals with regards to the Kingdom, for example you may aim to reach the point where you can consistently contribute a percentage of your income after tithe to His Work! or perhaps there is a certain figure you want to be able to contribute to His work by a certain date, or a monthly or annual figure or over your life!

And Finally **Goal#7** As I mentioned the key thing to remember is to make it a goal to use your hobbies & skills as opportunity for kingdom advancement. Ask the Spirit to guide you, how to use your skills to actually work as Co-Labourer with God.

Ask Him to help you, as you acquire new skills and hobbies to make new acquisitions of souls for His Kingdom!

And ask Him to give you goals in terms of what you actually want to accomplish for God in your ministry, with the skills you acquire, and the skills, talents and spiritual gifts you already have! Always remember with all the skills you have, that as much as the skills you have help, all that prospers under your hand is accomplished not by might, nor by power, BUT by God's Spirit!

So back to using your skills for His service, think about the wildest dream on a grand scale that you would love to accomplish! Maybe you want to build churches, schools and hospitals, maybe you want to finance missionary trips! Or send a million Bibles somewhere dig water wells in villages in Asia Africa South America!

Maybe you want to have a certain ongoing community project for a certain group of people! Or maybe you want to use your skills to meet a particular need of people in the community as an opportunity to witness! Maybe you have a goal to effectively franchise your model and operate in different locations WORLD WIDE! All of which are orientated around winning souls to the Kingdom! People are usually extremely responsive and are likely to want to listen to you, tell them about Jesus when you meet their needs without a self-serving agenda!

So think radical, think BIG, there are no limits, with God ALL things are possible! You can do all things through Christ Which strengthens you! God wants to show himself strong in you to the world!

Christ has His church as His representative on earth, and to it belongs the work of directing the repentant sinner in the way of life. You see, "... Jesus is the friend of sinners, and His heart is touched with their woe. He has all power, both in heaven and on earth; but He respects the means that He has ordained for the enlightenment and salvation of men; He directs sinners to the church, which He has made a channel of light to the world." (Acts of the Apostles p122)

You may recall in the early church the gospel was only being preached to the Jews. But it's not the will that any man perish, and God wanted to save the gentiles! There was a roman gentile called Cornelius, who was to be the first convert! He found favour with God as he revered God and took care of the poor! You can read about it in Acts chapter 10! But the point I want to make is an angel appeared to Cornelius and then to Peter to connect them together, so the gospel could be preached to the first gentile, you might know this story and if you do... Did you ever wonder to yourself, well why didn't the angel just preach the gospel to Cornelius?

"God gave evidence of His regard for the gospel ministry and for His organized church. The angel was not commissioned to tell Cornelius the story of the cross. A man subject, even as the centurion himself, to human frailties and temptations, was to be the one to tell him of the crucified and risen Saviour."

As His representatives among men, God does not choose angels who have never fallen, but human beings, men of like passions with those they seek to save. Christ took humanity that He might reach humanity. A divine-human Saviour was needed to bring salvation to the world. And to men and women has been committed the sacred trust of making known "the unsearchable riches of Christ." Ephesians 3:8.

In His wisdom the Lord brings those who are seeking for truth into touch with fellow beings who know the truth. It is the plan of Heaven that those who have received light shall impart it to those in darkness. Humanity, drawing its efficiency from the great Source of wisdom, is made the instrumentality, the working agency, through which the gospel exercises its transforming power on mind and heart." (Acts of the Apostles p134)

Now you may think Elliot I'm not called to be in the ministry! We all are called to be labourers in the Lord's vineyard. You may not be a minister but, you are still included in God's divine plan in winning souls for Jesus wherever you are!

The harvest truly is great, but the WILLING labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth WILLING labourers into his harvest... and give him permission to use you too... (Luke10:2).

Allow me for a moment if I may to share some words with you from one of my favourite writers Ellen White, she impressed by the Spirit expressed that some people feel... "Because they are not connected with some directly religious work, many feel that their lives are useless; that they are doing nothing for the advancement of God's kingdom. But this is a mistake. If their work is that which someone must do, they should not accuse themselves of uselessness in the great household of God. The humblest duties are not to be ignored. Any honest work is a blessing, and faithfulness in it may prove a training for higher trusts.

However lowly, any work done for God with a full surrender of self is as acceptable to Him as the highest service. No offering is small that is given with true-heartedness and gladness of soul.

Wherever we may be, Christ bids us take up the duty that presents itself. If this is in the home, take hold willingly and earnestly to make home a pleasant place. If you are a mother, train your children for Christ. This is as verily a work for God as is that of the minister in the pulpit. If your duty is in the kitchen, seek to be a perfect cook. Prepare food that will be healthful, nourishing, and appetizing. And as you employ the best ingredients in preparing food remember that you are to give your mind the best thoughts. If it is your work to till the soil or to engage in any other trade or occupation, make a success of the present duty. Put your mind on what you are doing. In all your work represent Christ. Do as He would do in your place.

However small your talent, God has a place for it. That one talent, wisely used, will accomplish its appointed work. By faithfulness in little duties, we are to work on the plan of addition, and God will work for us on the plan of multiplication. These littles will become the most precious influences in His work.

But many Christians are waiting for some great work to be brought to them. Because they cannot find a place large enough to satisfy their ambition, they fail to perform faithfully the common duties of life. These seem to them uninteresting. Day by day they let slip opportunities for showing their faithfulness to God. While they are waiting for some great work, life passes away, its purposes unfulfilled, its work unaccomplished."

"In the trust given to the first disciples, believers in every age have shared. Everyone who has received the gospel has been given sacred truth to impart to the world. God's faithful people have always been aggressive missionaries, consecrating their resources to the honor of His name and wisely using their talents in His service.

The unselfish labor of Christians in the past should be to us an object lesson and an inspiration. The members of God's church are to be zealous of good works, separating from worldly ambition and walking in the footsteps of Him who went about doing good. With hearts filled with sympathy and compassion, they are to minister to those in need of help, bringing to sinners a knowledge of the Saviour's love. Such work calls for laborious effort, but it brings a rich reward. Those who engage in it with sincerity of purpose will see souls won to the Saviour, for the influence that attends the practical carrying out of the divine commission is irresistible.

Not upon the ordained minister only rests the responsibility of going forth to fulfill this commission. Everyone who has received Christ is called to work for the salvation of his fellow men. "The Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come." Revelation 22:17. The charge to give this invitation includes the entire church. Everyone who has heard the invitation is to echo the message from hill and valley, saying, "Come."

It is fatal mistake to suppose that the work of soul-saving depends alone upon the ministry. The humble, consecrated believer upon whom the Master of the vineyard places a burden for souls is to be given encouragement by the men upon whom the Lord has laid larger responsibilities. Those who stand as leaders in the church of God are to realize that the Saviour's commission is given to all who believe in His name. God will send forth into His vineyard many who have not been dedicated to the ministry by the laying on of hands.

Hundreds, yea, thousands, who have heard the message of salvation are still idlers in the market place, when they might be engaged in some line of active service. To these Christ is saying, "Why stand ye here all the day idle?" and He adds, "Go ye

also into the vineyard." Matthew 20:6, 7. Why is it that many more do not respond to the call? Is it because they think themselves excused in that they do not stand in the pulpit? Let them understand that there is a large work to be done outside the pulpit by thousands of consecrated lay members.

Long has God waited for the spirit of service to take possession of the whole church so that everyone shall be working for Him according to his ability. When the members of the church of God do their appointed work in the needy fields at home and abroad, in fulfilment of the gospel commission, the whole world will soon be warned and the Lord Jesus will return to this earth with power and great glory. "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." Matthew 24:14." (Acts of the Apostles p109-111)
