I was impressed to create this series because, so many people have this false concept that every single thing that happens in life is up to God and His will!

And the problem with that is, a lot of God's will doesn't come to pass because people, think OK I can just let go and let God! But not EVERY thing is up to God, often the ball lies in **your** court!!! For example. 2Peter3:9 tells us that God is, "not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

He wants to save every soul, yet men perish daily, without coming to repentance! They were meant to be among God's harvest! Now... If it's not the will of God that ANY man perish, then it IS His will, that EVERY man be saved! Now you tell me does God's will ALWAYS come to pass? No!!! It doesn't! Why? Because in this case God has given you and I the responsibility of gathering His harvest for Him! So in some instances God's will coming to pass in our lives, is partly dependant on our efforts!

"The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest." Luke10:2 So it's not only God's will that you pray, but also that you will be a labourer too! There are people who's salvation is dependant on you approaching them! It's not the will of God that they perish, but if you don't do what God impresses you to do! They won't have a SHOT at salvation! You get the point!

Now on the other hand there are some instances where, there is nothing for you to do and all you CAN do is wait on God! It's outside of your power to do anything except pray! And in this case there are people who keep trying to interfere and do God's job when they should stay out of His way!

So then the relevant question is, "When is it appropriate for you to work and when is appropriate for you to let go and let God work???"

And that's what I'll be addressing in this video and I'm gonna try and keep it short but sweet!

Romans11:6 deals with the distinction between grace and work, at first I found it was a bit of a tongue twister, but after reading it a few times it began to become clear! It says if something is done, "...by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then it is no more grace: otherwise work is no more work."

I believe God's grace can be seen in everything we do! Whether the outcome He desires for us is dependant on our trust in Him by waiting on Him or whether the outcome He desires for us is dependant on our efforts! God's grace is needed in both situations... However there are times when we act inappropriately!

When we try to get involved, when God hasn't asked us to, this is "work of the flesh..." And when we don't get involved, when God has told us to, our "Faith without works is dead" I'll cover this in the 3 part series... When we get involved when God has asked us to it is Faith by Works! When we don't get interfere where God asked us not to, it is by HIS "grace" do you follow?

I'm gonna share with you some examples from Bible stories the difference between Dead Faith (without works), Works (of flesh) and Faith (by works)

Dead Faith (without works)

Jonah

Works (of flesh)

Abraham – Ishmael...

Faith (by works)

Woman with cakes, woman with sons and debt...

This all really boils down to you listening out for the voice of God! In other words when you pray for wisdom on what to do, to determine whether God wants you to work or wait on Him! How often have you waited for His answer? Do you pray and leave or do you pray and sit still and wait for a response? When you do God will impress upon you what He would like you to do!

By studying scripture and listening to what God impresses on your heart, you will be able to discern what God wants you to do! And you will know, when you are doing something wrong because you WILL feel something bugging you; If you are meant to be doing something and you aren't OR You are interfering when God just wants you to sit back and trust He has worked something out! Either way you will know!

Really the major issues here are first the importance of staying in your lane and second avoiding trying to do things in your own power without God! Whether you are meant to do something or not do something, you need God's assistance!

In EVERY case whatever He tells you, REMEMBER and recognise, whatever you involve yourself in and set your hand to do, you need His blessing for it to prosper, *"The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee."* Deuteronomy 28:8

If you see success from your efforts remember it's God blessing your efforts, it's "...NOT by might nor by power BUT by MY spirit saith the Lord of Hosts" Zechariah 4:6

I looked up the Hebrew word for "might" and that word is **ḥayil** used as a general term to covers a plethora of things, it describes, strength, capability, skill, valour, wealth, goods etc... I also looked up the Hebrew word for "power" it's **Kōah** this word is used to describe strength, power, might and ability often in reference to physical strength and the vigor of good health, or sometimes it's used to describe the ability to accomplish an action!

So what God is saying is that, when He accomplishes anything through you it is NOT by your strength, capability, skill, valour, wealth or goods, neither is it by your health and physical strength to accomplish an action... It is by MY Spirit, God says

Psalms 44:3 says, "For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them."

Deuteronomy 8:17-18 says, "And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth. But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth..."

God bestows upon us a rich measure of wisdom and grace, "When the mind of man is brought into communion with the mind of God, the finite with the Infinite, the effect on body and mind and soul is beyond estimate. In such communion is found the highest education. It is God's own method of development. "Acquaint now thyself with Him" (Job 22:21), is His message to mankind." (Acts of the Apostles p126)

God tells us, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts." Isaiah 55:8-9 "Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him..." Isaiah 55:7

"Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not." Jeremiah 33:3

"...it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God." 1 Corinthians 2:9-10

And God Wants GOOD For You...

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end." Jeremiah 29:11

"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." 3 John 2 "Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant." Psalm 35:27

"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly... But his delight is in the law of the LORD... And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." Psalm 1:1-3

When you have done all that there is to be done...

"Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise." Hebrews 10:35-36

REMEMBER it is "...NOT by might nor by power BUT by MY spirit saith the Lord of Hosts" Zechariah4:6

So rest in the Lord, hear these words from Psalm37...

³Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed. ⁴Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. ⁵Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. ⁶And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.

⁷**Rest in the LORD**, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass. ⁸Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil. ⁹For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

11 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.

²⁴Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand. ²⁵I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread. ²⁶He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed is blessed.

34**Wait on the LORD, and keep his way**, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land

40...the LORD shall help them, and deliver them... and save them, because they trust in him" Psalm37:3-9, 23-26, 34,40

What needs to ultimately happen is you need to LOOSE confidence in yourself, every time you do you, you tell God, "*I take better care of myself than you, I am my own Lord!*"

YES God has given you power and praise God for it but... Rejoice not in the possession of your power and ability, lest you lose sight of your dependence upon God. Be careful lest self-sufficiency come in, and you work in your own strength, rather than in the spirit and strength of your Master. Self is ever ready to take the credit if any measure of success attends the work. Self is flattered and exalted, and the impression is not made upon other minds that God is all and in all. The apostle Paul says, "When I am weak, **then** am I strong." 2Cor12:10.

When we have a realization of our weakness, **we learn to depend upon a power not inherent**. Nothing can take so strong a hold on the heart as the abiding sense of our responsibility to God.

We are to come in touch with God, then we shall be imbued with His Holy Spirit. While you look higher than yourself, you will have a continual sense of the weakness of humanity. The less you cherish self, the more distinct and full will be your comprehension of the excellence of your Saviour.

The more closely you connect yourself with the source of light and power, the greater light will be shed upon you, and the greater power will be yours to work for God.

The church is built upon Christ/The Word as its foundation; it is to obey Christ/The Word as its head. It is not to depend upon man, or be controlled by man. The Rock of faith is the living presence of Christ in the church. Upon this the weakest may depend, and those who think themselves the strongest will prove to be the weakest, **unless they make Christ their efficiency.** "Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm." The Lord "is the Rock, His work is perfect." "Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him." Jer. 17:5; Deut. 32:4; Ps. 2:12.

I pray this has made clear to you the differences between Dead Faith (without works), Works (of flesh) and Faith (by works) people do get confused sometimes and often cause themselves more problems, than are absolutely necessary... So it is important that you bare in mind the differences, it really can be the difference that makes or breaks your success!
