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**MY NOTES**  
(From What God Impresses On My Heart)

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**A) Make SURE You Live In Consistent Obedience with God's Commands...**



"There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee....be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper withersoever thou goest.

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success." Joshua1:5,7-8

Surrender your will to God's Will be obedient.

**Surrendering All to Obey = Victory Always**

"And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments... the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God." Deuteronomy28:1-2

**B) Be SURE the Scripture You Stand On IS Relevant for Your Situation...**



Don't go into a spiritual fight without your armour. The armour is essentially the Word of God. If you go into a fight unarmed without God or His Word. You will feel like you got into a gang fight only your gang didn't show up! So what I recommend for you to do, in order to get the right Word for your situation is to invest in one of those booklets which have a list of specific scriptures to be used under different circumstances. Also invest in a concordance to help you compare related scriptures. Pray for guidance and God will reveal the one to be used for your situation!

Faith can't come if you don't have the Word. If you don't have the Word you don't have faith and without faith your victory is non existent. "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, **even our faith.**" 1John5:4

The Word is a sword it's a weapon (Ephesians6:17). God has laid before you in His Word an entire elaborate range of artillery fit to annihilate any enemy you face. Be sure to select the correct weapon to ensure your victory.

*God's* WILL *For* **YOU** IS *Victory*

The Psalmist wrote that, "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple." Psalm 119:130

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**C) Be SURE You Aren't Practicing Wrong Doing...**



As explained in the Faith Booster, "The Just Shall *LIVE* by Faith..." Jesus compares The Word of God with a seed being planted, with the objective of getting a harvest. Here's the thing, sin hinders the growth of the seed of faith you sow and it also hinders confidence.

1John3:21 says, "Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God."

**When you are in sin, you know you are not in right standing with God, so you start condemning yourself.** You loose confidence in the word producing FOR (**you**). So make sure you're confident you are right with God, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1John1:9

Hebrews12:1 says, "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us"

The Amplified version says, "THEREFORE THEN, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who have borne testimony to the Truth], let us strip off and throw aside every encumbrance (unnecessary weight) and that sin which so readily (deftly and cleverly) clings to and entangles us, and let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us"

"Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law." (1John3:4)

The law of God must be obeyed for manifestation to happen Matthew6:33 confirms this is true. God has set laws and when you aren't in line with them, you are in sin, you are transgressing from the law. The wages of sin is death (Romans6:23), that means you go backwards, any Word(Seeds) you planted in the soil of your heart will die and wither away producing no fruit.

**So admit your guilt forget making excuses.** The Bible says in the New Living Translation (NLT) "People who cover over their sins will not prosper. But if they confess and forsake them, they will receive mercy." (Proverbs28:13 NLT).

**Accept Christ's forgiveness...** He's waiting to clean your slate. Ask him to clear your conscience, and then remember "there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1 NLT).

So knowing that, forgive yourself also and focus on moving forward. "Do not remember the past events, pay no attention to things of old. Look, I am about to do something new; even now it is coming. Do you not see it? Indeed, I will make a way in the wilderness, rivers in the desert" (Isaiah 43:18-19 HCSB).

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**D) Make SURE No Doubt/Unbelief Is In the Field Amongst Your Seed...**



This is where the devil will use his power of suggestion that what God has promised won't come to pass. He usually discourages you by using the fact that, what you want is taking a while longer than **you** want it to... Only He lies and tells you it ain't ever gonna happen! But the Word says;

"Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry." Hebrews 10:35-37

Look at Abraham even though circumstances weren't ideal, check out his attitude, "Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

*And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead,* when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb:

*He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;*

And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform." Romans 4:18-21

Abraham didn't consider his body which was old, As far as He was concerned He was the father of many nations. The bad report didn't deter him. Don't let bad reports of your situation deter you. Philippians 4:8 says, "Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, **whatsoever things are of good report;** if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." The Word is the good report so think on that thing.

"Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;" 2 Corinthians 10:5

Anything that tries to lift itself as more significant than the Word in your heart cast it down, bring it into captivity to the obedience of the Word. I know that the scripture says Christ but scripture tells us Christ is also called "The Word of God" so bringing your thoughts to the obedience of Christ is to be in obedience with The Word.

After you have prayed do as Abraham did be, "**strong in faith, giving glory to God...**" So just keep thanking Him as if you have the physical materialisation of what you asked for. The seed is in the ground, it's coming up. Tolerate no thought other than what the Word says.

**The BEST most effective way you cast down thoughts is with words...  
MORE specifically with God's Word, The Word YOU are standing on.**

When doubt comes say, The Word you are standing on out loud and interrupt the thought in your mind. You **MUST** SAY IT OUT LOUD in order to successfully interrupt it, otherwise you're just fighting with thoughts.

You MUST say it loud. If you just fight a thought with a thought it's not as effective. You can't fight a thought with a thought, just like you can't fight fire with fire. You fight thoughts with words like you fight fire with water. So when the devil launches those fiery darts (of thought) at you, you respond with the living water of the spoken Word. Boy that's good even if I say so myself, thank you JESUS!

You may battle like that for a while, but after a while, all that will be in your mind is the Word. **"Submit yourselves therefore to God.** Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." James4:7

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Here's how you do it... Say for example you have a thought of doubt regarding your needs being supplied! And the enemy says to you; "God ain't gonna meet your need this time, He may have before but this time is different!"

"Shut up devil! Don't ramp with me I'm warning you! You might wanna mess with me now, but you won't wanna mess with me in a second cos, I'm calling my big brother Jesus, you better get out of here... Too late I'm calling Him right now! You parade around seeking whom you MAY devour, but you ain't gonna devour ME!

Jesus, Satan's trying to mess with the seeds you planted in my heart again! You deal with Him for me! I can do all things when you strengthen me!"

Then Holy Spirit, Jesus' assistant hands you a MASSIVE machine gun, loaded with bullets (these bullets are "The Word of God") Jesus promised in John16:26, "...the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall... bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."

And you say, "Devil say hello to MASSIVE friend!!!" And you start firing the word of God you're standing on at Him! Each word of the scripture you say is a bullet and even though He flees, you keep firing more!

"My God shall supply ALL my needs according to HIS riches in glory by Christ Jesus" That's one round or clip, Holy Spirit brings you another clip and you reload!

"No I'm not done yet? You should no better than to try ramp with me! I still got more, guess what else, "In the time of famine, I won't be ashamed, I'll be satisfied" NEXT CLIP "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall have want for nothing" "I will always have all sufficiency in all things not only that I have enough to abound to EVERY good work" "My bread is sure" "The righteous have never been forsaken"

You know what you're doing, when you do this? It's called fighting the good fight of faith! You know why it's called a good fight? Because you ALWAYS win! Submit to God and He will flee from you! Jesus did the same thing, He responded out loud, "it is written, it is written... it is written!"

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**MY NOTES**  
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**E) Give Glory To God Even BEFORE You SEE Manifestation...**



Give GOD thanks giving gratitude for what you have received by faith, when you are awaiting manifestation. "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." Phillipians4:6 Don't wait until you see manifestation to give thanks! Start NOW!

"Thine, O LORD is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the **victory**, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all." 1Chronicles29:11

"But thanks be to God, which giveth us the **victory** through our Lord Jesus Christ." 1Corinthians15:57

"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the **victory...**" 1John5:4

Act in faith as though you have received what you asked for, physically. You may recall I shared an example with you in "God's Will For you IS Prosperity";

A Business Principle which explains brilliantly how I've noticed God likes to operate is "Just In Time" production. When a car is manufactured, in just in time production... As the car moves along the assembly line, all the parts for that car, arrive just in time as the car reaches the position where it needs it's part.

God tells us, to keep moving forward in faith and as soon as the project needs the funds or other resources God somehow pulls the pieces together just in time. Now the truth is, He already worked out before you were even born, how He would work it out, and He has given us everything that pertains unto life!

But we can't visibly see that, we just take God at His word! The Just LIVE by faith! Sometimes the resources you think you need to go ahead, won't be visible, until you get right up until the point where it is needed. And I believe God's reasoning for this is to train us to trust Him.

When the resources you need for a project aren't visible, keep moving forward in faith, as if you are in a car factory and you KNOW the part you need WILL BE THERE right when you need it. Often we don't have the resources ahead of time. This is why God said the just shall live by faith and we walk BY faith not by sight ([Romans 1:17](#) & [2 Corinthians 5:7](#))

Show God you are confident, He will deliver don't keep begging Him to do something! Praise Him for what you KNOW He has already done! You asked according to His Will, so you know He heard you and therefore you can be confident that you have the petitions you desired of Him! Because when you asked you believe you received, it's a done deal so praise Him and give Him glory thanking Him for what you have received! Keep moving forward as God directs with no physical evidence of resources.

Soon you will be with the visible manifestation of the Word God promised!!! Give Him praise!!!

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## *God's WILL For YOU IS Victory*

Ok so that was the checklist, if you tick all the boxes. Victory is yours for CERTAIN. I just want to spend a few more minutes to give you some inspiration and encouragement to keep going through hard times...

### **WE ARE IN A VISCIOUS WAR, WITH AN UNSEEN UNRELENTING & REMORSELESS ENEMY...**

OK Elliot that sounds encouraging. Thanks a lot. Hear me out... I don't want to make that your constant focus. But you MUST be aware of it. You should FOCUS on God and His goodness, because that is what will see you through...

It's sad to see many believers live and walk without a sense of war. They are at "ease" and that is why they are constantly down. If an enemy is fighting you, and you do not seem to know it, you make his victory certain and easy. But the Bible has given a clear understanding that the Christian life is a life of constant war. But we have no reason to fear;

"For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith." 1John5:4

He who **is** (in you) (**is**) **greater** than he who is in the world. Faith in that word is all you need to keep the enemy where he belongs (under your feet)

You are to stay focused and resist the evil one at all cost. Every time he attacks, just say, "My help [**cometh**] from the LORD, which made heaven and earth." (Psalms 121:2)

"The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, Until I make thy foes thy footstool." Acts2:34-35.

If a foe is your footstool, they are under your feet, **that means you are above standing on top of them.** "...the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above **only**, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God... to observe and to do them" Deuteronomy28:13.

Jesus said, "**Behold, I give you the authority to trample... over **all** the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.**" Luke10:19

### **You Are More Than A Conqueror...**

"...in all these things we are more than **conquerors** through him that loved us." Romans 8:37

### **You Are An Overcomer...**

"...because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you... ye have overcome the wicked one." 1John2:14

"Ye are of God, little children, and have **overcome...**: because **greater is he** that (is) IN YOU, than he that is in the world." 1John4:4

"For whatsoever is born of God **overcometh** the world: and this is the victory that **overcometh** the world, even our faith." 1John5:4

**Recognize who the enemy is and what he comes to do...** "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." Ephesians6:12

"The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy..." John10:10  
"Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to  
withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand." Ephesians6:13

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## *God's WILL For YOU IS Victory*

"Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses."  
1Timothy6:12

Victory is already yours. Jesus obtained the victory. Your job is to obey His commands to secure the victory in your situation. The victory is already obtained, all that is needed is your obedience and it will manifest.

For example 1 Peter 2:24 "Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye **were** healed."

"Were" in the past tense. The past tense is only used for something already done. You aren't trying to get something that you don't have, it has already been given to you. Now you simply need to grab hold onto what is already yours by claiming your victory THROUGH obedience. When you are afraid to obey (*usually this is due to external influences, which you can't see being resolved if you do obey...*) That is Satan is trying to take away, your victory. Satan comes to steal, kill and destroy.

Satan can't steal from you, kill or destroy what you don't already have. So that is proof you have something already, that he doesn't want you to have. So He is trying to stop you from obeying, so your victory can't manifest. His power is through suggestion. He knows we can't see, we have to walk by faith. So He turns the heat up on our circumstances to give us REASONS to fear being obedient. Let's see what God has to say about this;

"Be **not afraid** nor dismayed by reason... for the **battle** is **not** yours, but God's."  
(2Chronicles20:15)

"When thou goest out to battle against thine enemies, and seest horses, and chariots, and a people more than thou, be **not afraid of them**: for the LORD thy God **is with thee...**" (Deuteronomy 20:2)

So say to your enemies and circumstances "...the **battle** is the **LORD's**, and he will give you into our hands." (1Samuel17:47)

David wrote "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken..." Psalm25:37

REMEMBER keep, "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith..."  
Hebrews12:2

Remember victory is yours, just be patient. God will come through. He WILL not forsake the righteous. In fact He CAN'T... It is my prayer this will be of great help to you, I'm praying for you and your victory in everything, peace and love...



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
