Overcome Fear

Did you know that “fear” is not real? Well if you didn’t, I’m telling you now it’s not. Fear is merely a construct of the mind, it’s an idea... a false idea that whatever you try won’t work. Fear only has power when you choose to give it any by choosing to believe it! You believe it by acting on it. And to act on fear is to **not** do something.

Procrastinating is “acting...” on fear. You always act on something, either faith or fear. Every time you chose to act on nothing you acted on fear. As long as you are doing something moving you forward, you are acting in faith. If you allow fear to affect you, it can reduce or even eliminate the potential impact you and others could benefit from.

If you think about it fear actually comes from not knowing the results our present actions will yield in the future. We can only be fearful about future events and since the future isn’t here yet, fear isn’t here either. Knowing fear isn’t real, isn’t it strange how we let what isn’t real, affect what IS real and that is us.

Since fear doesn’t exist, it is “nothing”. How often have you let “nothing” stop you? You let nothing rob you of something. Something real which affects your real life. Fear makes problems look more significant than they are and it makes your capabilities to handle those potential obstacles look insignificant.

Jesus said “Men's hearts failing them for fear... **looking** after those things which are **(coming)** on the earth...” (Luke21:26). Things which aren’t even here yet, things which aren’t even an issue we worry about them. Job did this expecting something bad to happen to Him, he kept praying and making sacrifices, in fear of His family not being right with God. He was paranoid something bad would happen to Him. Then look what Job said happened, “For the thing which **I** greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.” (Job3:25)

There is an acronym for F.E.A.R. It stands for **F**alse **E**xpectations **A**ppearing **R**eal. Fear is literally an illusion created by our minds. Although an illusion maybe there you can still take action knowing you are in possession of the ability to achieve your dream. You’ve heard the phrase I’m sure, “If you can conceive it, you can achieve it.” I believe that to be true, because I believe it is impossible to have the conception of an idea without there already being a way for the objective to be achieved.

When we step forward each step of the road is revealed. Like person driving a car, in the dark only sees a few feet ahead of them at a time. They keep going and as they come up to turns and hills and bumps and pot holes and traffic they make adjustments along the way.

Nobody stays in the driveway of their home because they can’t see all the way to their destination. They trust that the roadway to their destination is already in place and although there maybe obstacles along the way. Bad weather may cause accidents or obscure vision, a blocked road my cause a detour, a traffic jam might mean they might not get to where they wanted to in the time they wanted. But despite all this they determine no matter what obstacles may come either way they **WILL** get to their destination, whichever way is available they will adjust their plans. Getting where they want to be is the main point in concern!

The important thing is not the obstacles but the destination. Nothing really stops them starting their journey; they know they will deal with obstacles when they get to them. They know eventually they will arrive where they want to be.

You know one thing I've learnt is that, fear is self-centred. It's ALWAYS worrying about me, me, me, me. What if Jesus was to worry about Himself because of fear of what He was going to go through and say, "Forget this! I ain't going through all that!" We'd be in trouble. Think of the others who will benefit from your stepping forward in spite of the idea that, what you do won't work or you'll get rejected or you'll fail. "Jesus... who FOR THE JOY that was set before Him endured the cross..." (Hebrews12:2). Perfected love casts out fear (1John4:18).

Love overpowers. Love is what empowered Christ, His compassion for the well being of others made Him choose to make Himself be uncomfortable for the greater good. The good of our benefit and the joy, He will receive when we get to be with Him in heaven.

When you are at the point where you know you want to take action, but you feel intimidated by something for whatever reason. Give yourself a reality check, identify what your fear is... Then ask what if this fear was to happen to you today, what is the worse that can happen, IF it happens? Really think about that fear go into detail, about what would happen. Use the questions in the FAITH BOOSTER "*Faith with Works...Works...*" to help you.

After I get through that exercise I find the extreme worse case scenario is I will die. Now... If I die because I decided to move forward in doing what I believe God asked me to do. The next time I open my eyes. I'll be rising up out of my grave to meet with my Lord and Saviour in the air. I will hear the words, "Well done thou good and faithful servant" (Matthew25:21). Following that I'll be escorted on a gold street which looks like transparent glass (Revelation21:21), up to my custom made mansion of my dreams, living in more lavish luxury than anything I'd ever seen on earth... (John14:2-3 & 1Corinthians2:9)!

I will bite into a fruit tastier than anything I'd ever tasted in my life and then sit back knowing, I will never experience pain again, I will never shed another tear and I will have the peace of mind and unparalleled joy that this awesome pleasure is going to last forever and ever and ever... (Revelation21:4) And most important of All I will have honoured God!

I don't know about you but I'd rather that, than hear Jesus say, "Sorry I never knew you, depart from me" (Matthew7:23). Just because you call Jesus, "Lord" doesn't mean you'll be saved, you have to do the will of the Father (Matthew7:21). If your excuse for not doing what He asked you was, "I was afraid" Jesus will respond "...Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?" (Mark4:40). I don't want to hear that. I don't know about you, but to me it's not worth choosing to live, for fear of dying. I'd rather die doing what God has asked of me.

Being out of the will of God in order to live is not worth living for anyway. So whatever God calls me to do, whatever it is I'm going for it. If you can take the worse, then take the risk, God will not put you through anything you are unable to bare (1Corinthians10:13) He promises that.

Don't allow fear to overcome you, YOU overcome fear. If you can't overcome fear for the love of God and the sheer appreciation of the lengths of compassion He went out of His way to save you, then think of what God has in store for you, as your reward for being obedient.

An excellent way to overcome fear is to take action and EVERY time you get the result you want, log it down in a diary. Eventually you will have a book-FULL of the times you were afraid to do something but despite that, you did it and you succeeded. You'll find yourself more willing to step out into the unfamiliar for fear of missing out on the results you might get. When you review, your book and see all the times, you had success come your way. It is just so encouraging.

Let me share something with you, which people don't realise and it is simply because they don't think enough. The reason successful people have more success than most people is because they make more effort than most people and therefore in making that effort they have faced more rejections than most. They make effort so many times that they experience successes and therefore more rejections and setbacks than most people.

Here is the thing **people rarely talk about their failures**, they talk about their successes. So when you hear for example someone has 100 successes and you think they are special because you only have 10. Just think about how many times they may have had failure in order to have those 100 successes. They may have had 500 tries at something. So their success rate is 20%. If you take the same percentile success rate to a smaller scale. If that SAME person only tried 5 times, with the same success rate they would only have 1 success.

The point is if YOU make effort on a larger scale than you are now, with the same success rate you currently have you would INEVITABLY have more successes. And more than most people. Yes you will experience more rejections, but you will also experience more successes. And since people tend to only talk about their successes. The person who faces the most setbacks can have the pleasure of talking about the most successes.

Here is the really good part... Eventually their actual success rate improves even further. Because they have failed so many times that each time they found something that they needed to work on. Then 70-80% of everything they ever try is successful. That's how it works it's a number game.

"More Quantity of effort means more quantity of success and MORE SETBACKS... which means more improvements; Which means a more frequent percentile of success, which when combined with more quantity of effort means CONSISTENT SUCCESS with virtually everything you set your hand to..."

Now the first time you do anything is the scariest time, because you are inexperienced. But you have to just do it. Once you do it once successfully, it's easier the 2nd time. After a while it's something you do with confidence. Success will create more confidence, which will create more successes. It all starts with taking the first step. Eventually your steps turn into rapid steps, walking briskly before long you're running a flat out full sprint. With that kind of momentum, even if somebody tripped you up, you couldn't help but fly forward.

"That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work..." (Colossians 1:10).

In the FAITH BOOSTER "*Persistence and Patience Until Due Season.*" You will hear me talk about work ethic. You will understand the mindset and work ethic of **SERIAL WINNERS**.

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Don't let somebody convince you that winning isn't important. It IS. God is the one who teaches you to PROFIT which I would class as winning! (Isaiah48:17) God fired his steward who didn't get a profit with His resources and gave it to Him who was making profit! Therefore winning is important to God and it should be for you! If you don't go into anything with the intention of winning then what is the point? We are supposed to do everything with all our might, giving it our all as unto God.

However if you don't win, you haven't lost, you had a set back, you only lose when you give up. Don't allow that to get in your way, you may have lost the battle but you will surely win the war.

Be encouraged to improve your skills and make adjustments, that is the attitude of a winner. By getting up after a setback, you won against that circumstance. Winning gives you confidence and courage. If your outcome is not what you expected learn to appreciate the opportunity to learn a valuable lesson and grow stronger. Setbacks are not designed to defeat you. You are designed to defeat setbacks.

"No" is not an answer you accept, it's a challenge to make yourself better so that you become more persuasive to get a "yes." Work on becoming a better, more attractive package which people will struggle to find a reason to resist saying anything other than "yes" to you. It's often a numbers game the more you persist the more yeses you will get.

A lot of the time we are afraid to move forward just because of a fear of words...

A lot of successes are stopped because people are afraid of what other people will have to say... About what they think about them. Here is the thing, people think about you, whatever they like, whatever it is, they are gonna think about it anyway, so you might as well just do whatever it is, your gonna do! At some point what they may have said about you in the past which was discouraging will change to words of praise for your efforts and praise to God for what He has done through you.

And you know what? Some people will always criticize, they won't change. Who cares? Why should a fear of "**words**" stop you? And by that time, you'll be used to moving into action despite what the nay sayers say, proving you were right all the time. God has promised if you do as He commands, whatever you set your hand will prosper (Deuteronomy28:8). No man can stand before you (Joshua1:5). It's not about what they want you to have, it's about what you know you can do with God.

Sometimes we think that if we do everything right, everything we do will fall in place... What I have discovered is that what is "supposed" to fall into place, will fall into place. Even with rejection, when you are working as unto God, things WILL work out. All things work together for good for them that love God, those who "love" God, do his commandments! If you are doing as God has instructed all things, that means good AND bad will work together for good!

Sometimes we are fearful because, we believe people who tell us we can't do something... You need to understand the REAL reason why they say you can't, for you to see why YOU actually can! The reason they say you can't is because they don't think they can... or because it has never been done before (as far as they know).

There is always something that has never been done quite like you can do it. So that's why you're doing it and that's why you CAN do it. Don't accept what others

say as the truth and give up. Accept it as your challenge to move the bench mark of the status quo.

The top and bottom of it all is...

Whether you think you can... **or** you think you can't...
(Whatever your reasons maybe...)

YOU ARE ALWAYS RIGHT!!!

If you think you CAN'T...

YOU ARE RIGHT!!!

If you think you CAN...

YOU ARE RIGHT AGAIN!!!

WHY???

3 reasons...

"For as (man) thinketh in his heart so is he..." (Proverbs23:7 emphasis added)

"According to **YOUR** faith be it unto you..." Matthew9:29

"With Man it is impossible but WITH **GOD** all things are possible..."

"...faith... *worketh by love*..." Galatians 5:6

"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear... He that feareth is not made perfect in love." 1John 4:18

"Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness... as he (God) is, **so are we...**" 1John 4:17 (Emphasis added)

"And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. **God IS love**; and he that dwelleth *in love* dwelleth in God, and God in him." 1John 4:16

In anything you feel impressed to do, but you feel fearful to move forward. Overcome that fear with passionate love for what you do. When you become passionate enough, to the point where it is a burning obsession, you will be determined to do whatever it takes by any righteous means necessary to make it work. When you have determined to make something be so. That is the only thing which matters to you, any obstacles must give way. You are unrelenting refusing to relinquish your pursuit. Even if you risk death, you will still go for it just to make that dream reality.

Passion will make you do things which under normal circumstances you wouldn't do. A woman maybe afraid of fire and would never walk into a burning building or over hot coals. But when that woman is a mother of a child who is in danger and going through a burning building or walking over hot coals is the only available option to save her child. Once she has determined in her heart I will save my child. She will go through whatever obstacle risking injury and or death to save her child.

If you were on a street watching a building burn down and I approached you and said, "You know I hear the fire brigade are 10 minutes away."

You say to yourself, "Wow the building could be completely gone by then!" Then I say to you, "Be honest, would you be brave enough to walk into a burning building?"

You would consider things "Could I?" "Would I?" "SHOULD I?" "Can I?" "What If?" "If I did, how?"

Then frantically someone comes running up to you saying, "Oh my goodness, there is a baby in there!"

You say, "Really where?"

I reply, "Oh yeah look on the 3rd floor 2nd window from the right..."

You look and you realise there is a baby on the windowsill. You look closer and you think hold on a minute, "That's my baby." Knowing the fire brigade won't be arriving for another 9 minutes, you are off like a rocket into that building. All those questions you had before aren't even a consideration. All you know is you are saving your baby.

Nothing else matters until that baby is safe. Am I right? or am I correct?

You have to want your dream to manifest **as much** as you want the safety of your baby from that burning building. In fact your dream or vision is that baby, it's your baby. I often hear people refer to the thing they build or the dream they

have as "my baby." Perhaps you ought to think of your dream as "your baby" to remind you of the fact that your dream is in a burning building until you manifest it, into this physical realm which is the only safe place for it to be.

Now let's say getting the baby outside the burning building is the manifestation of that dream. Just like manifestation of the baby's safety. Every moment you waste afraid to save your dream, you are increasing the chances of the death of your dream.

When your baby was in that burning building and you went to save it. You forgot your questions and the objective of saving your baby was all that was on your mind. You didn't give the circumstances a moments thought. You didn't think can I or can't I? You thought "**I WILL**" "**I MUST**" and you did. You were right because you knew you could. You only thought about your baby's safety. So the question I will ask you about your dream "your baby" is;

How much do you want, what you want?

Your dream or vision is the baby in that burning building, there is no better time to act other than now, the conditions aren't important! When you love your dream or vision as much as your own baby, you will do anything to save it protect it and keep it safe. You will let nothing stand in your way until you manifest it into this outside world. Think of your vision or dream as "YOUR BABY" in the burning building (which is the spiritual realm where things are not seen) and "YOUR BABY" is not safe until you go in that building grab hold of "YOUR BABY" and run with it until it is outside the burning building (In the physical realm where it is seen) safe and sound.

From this moment onwards only think of your dream as "your baby" in a burning building until it is outside that building. Whatever needs to be done to get it out of that building Just DO IT. As you do this you get into a momentum and a state, where action is continuous, it becomes habit, a way of life, **your** way of life. Apply this analogy for any unrealised dream you have, which is in danger until it is manifested.

No one is more passionate about saving **your** baby than you are. Whatever you do, be confident God is with you all the way. You may get burned a little or severely here and there, you may fall, breath in smoke, these are all circumstances trying to stop you from bringing your vision "your baby" outside the spiritual unseen world into the visible world. Pay them no mind make sure your baby is safe.

On the other side of fear is success... It should be more scary to miss out on your dream, than to act on it and attain it. Just like it is more scary to see your baby burn than to run in that burning building and get it out. In order to get something you never had, you have to do something you have never done.

So just go for it. Whatever God has called you to do, "Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ" (Phillipians1:6). "...we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." (Romans8:28).

Isaiah54:17 says, "No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper..." It didn't say some it said NO WEAPON!!! It didn't say weak weapons won't prosper against thee, but maybe there is a slim chance some strong weapons formed against you will prosper. No Weapon!!! That excludes nothing. Now it does say no weapon that is formed against you will prosper. So you can be certain weapons will be formed against you but none of them will be permitted to prosper in their cause to destroy you or your dream, "your baby".

Joshua 1:5 says, "There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee."

You know what this means for you... Nobody or no thing which tries to stand in your way will be able to. *It's not about what they will let you have, it's about what you want.* You don't let the burning building stop you saving "your baby" God is with you and won't fail you. Trustful dependence on Jesus makes victory not only possible but **100% CERTAIN!!!**

You have not been given the spirit of fear, perfected love cast out fear, God is love therefore there is no fear in Him. Fear is not of Him, fear is therefore of the devil, trying to rob you blind and God from His dream coming to pass, through you being scared. The devil hates God and will hurt Him by setting the building where your baby is on fire to stop you trying to bring it outside. He hates God and tries to scare you to stop what God wants to happen. The devil is a thief,

Fear is a thief and, "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy..." Jesus said, "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." (John10:10)

"For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father." (Romans8:15)

"The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe." Proverbs29:25

If "...faith worketh (BY) love" (Galatians5:6). Then doubt works by Fear and fear stops faith. You need unwavering faith to operate in God's principles (see James1:7-8 & Hebrews11:6). Perfected love casts out fear, "There is no fear in love... He that feareth is not made perfect in love" (1John4:18).

When you love God with all your heart as He recommends, you are loyal to Him. You are more concerned about honouring His word because you are so in love and want to do right by Him, you aren't even concerned about what man can do to you or what circumstance will come against you if you obey Him.

Love will make you do that, love will make you run into a highway, walk into a burning building take your chances attacking a wild animal when someone you love is in danger. When circumstances arise where we have to choose between obeying God or man; the one who we care about is being attacked!

We should run to defend Him and His Word against anything that exalts itself against Him, as if wild animal is attacking Him. We must submit to God and bring our situation to the obedience of Christ. We should rather burn alive than go contrary to what God says, only love can accomplish that. When God is with you no man or circumstance can be against you.

I'm going to read to you from Romans8:28-39 it says, "And we know that **all things work together for good to them that love God**, to them who are the called according to his purpose. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, **them he also glorified**."

What shall we then say to these things? **If God be for us, who can be against us?** He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, **how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?** Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.

Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. **Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?** shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

Nay, IN ALL these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us... For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:28-39

Psalm 112:7-8 says, "He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies."

Psalm 46:1-2 says, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;"

And I'm sure you know this one from Psalm 23:4 it says, "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear **no evil: for THOU art with me**; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me."

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When you go out to do the Will of God Pray for boldness and compassion

those are the two things we need to go out and save the lost. We need boldness to speak the Word of God to the lost boldly and we need compassion to actually want to take responsibility for their souls. When we let opportunities bypass us without saying anything to people about what Jesus did for them, we are demonstrating that we don't have enough compassion to get them to safety. Especially people we don't like, we need a sincere compassion for them! Those people will not make it to heaven if you don't say anything!

Don't just assume they are hard hearted and won't listen to you or may even ridicule you. When you are passionate enough about their well being you won't care about being ridiculed, you'll care more about giving them the chance to accept the Salvation Jesus provided for them. It is your job to minister to them and ultimately it is their decision. Just do your part Holy Spirit will speak to their hearts and take it from there.

Don't feel discouraged if they don't take to what you say. You have sown the seed and someone else may be used to reel them in and you may never know or see them give their lives to Christ. But when you get to Heaven and see them there, what a pleasant surprise it will be. Especially when they say to you, "Thank you, if you hadn't had said anything I wouldn't be here."

Jesus died for them too not just you. He went through a lot to get them saved He is now depending on you. He saved you, now save them. Do you want their blood on your hands? I don't think so... Jesus was gracious and had compassion for us we must have it for others. The love of God is inside us. We dwell in Him, He dwells in us.

The combination of compassion and boldness are what we need to accomplish the work of God and then finally we can go home. This is our mission as believers. When the gospel is preached to the entire world then shall the coming of the Son of Man be.

I spoke earlier about having a loving passion and undying obsession for "your baby." We must pass this passion on to saving the lost. They are "God's Babies" He wants them home. He is not willing that any of them perish. The passion you have for "your baby" is the same compassion you must have for the souls of the lost. They are your brothers and sisters. So give your all into making sure they come out of that burning building alive for God. Your compassion will give birth to boldness.

Now let's talk about boldness...

Ecclesiastes 8:1 says, "Who is as the wise man? and who knoweth the interpretation of a thing? a man's wisdom maketh his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed." As you become wise your face shines brighter and you will become more bold as you become wise.

So if you want boldness a good place to start would be becoming wise, James 1:5 says, "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him." Once wisdom is given to you boldness will come with it.

You can also ask for boldness, look what happened in Acts 4:29,31 "And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all **boldness** they may speak thy word..."

And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with **boldness**."

Ephesians 3:10-12 says, "...powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold **wisdom** of God, According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord: In whom we have boldness AND access with confidence (by) the faith of him." If we have faith in the wisdom God has given us to do with His Word that He will be with us. We will have boldness WITH confidence.

"For I know that... through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, **According to my earnest expectation and my hope**, that **in nothing** I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, *as always*, so now also Christ shall be magnified..." (Phillipians1:19-20). *Pray, earnestly for compassion and boldness expect it, you won't be ashamed because God won't let you down.*

He loves you and will give you all things to help you (Romans8:32) if you ask Him (Matthew7:7) and He won't fail you (Joshua1:5). He won't let you down, will not forsake you (Psalm37:25).

"So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it" (Isaiah11:55).
