You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

"And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry: And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. And Jesus answered and said unto it, **No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever.** And his disciples heard it...

And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**" (Mark11:12-14,20-23)

WOW isn't that AMAZING or is it? Should it be amazing to us? Shouldn't this be a normal occurrence in the life of Christian's experience? Is this really possible for us?

Didn't Jesus say, "**He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.**" (John14:12)

Luke6:40 says, "The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be **as** his master." "As He is in this world so ARE WE..." (1John4:17)

YOU SHALL DECREE A THING AND IT **SHALL** COME TO PASS...

This power has been made available to you... Therefore it IS available to you... Jesus **HIMSELF** said you can do as He does and this isn't something intended for times passed. Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever. He is also no respecter of persons. So this includes every person in the body of Christ regardless of who you are or which era in which you were born. All of us can do this. Jesus only had one criteria "**HE THAT BELIEVETH ON ME...**"

So how exactly do we harness this power and put it to use for God???

Jeremiah33:3 says, "Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not."

If you have a cross reference in your Bible. You will see where other words have been used to explain what the scripture says. So if we substitute the words in the text with the words in the cross reference in the text we just read, it will read, "Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and **INACCESSIBLE** things, which thou knowest not." The Word says, "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding" (Proverbs4:7). So, I'll be referring to cross references so you can get a good understanding of what God has said to you.

"Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is **of God**; that we might know **the things** that are **freely given** TO US of God." (1Corinthians2:12)

OK...

So let's get to the exciting part and examine the **proof** that **YOU can actually decree/declare things** and "**see**" your words come to pass...

You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

MY NOTES

(From What God Impresses On My Heart)

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Jesus said, "All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth" (Matthew 28:18.) He told us, "Behold, I give unto you power..." (Luke 10:19). "Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matthew 18:18).

When you release God's LIVING Word out of your mouth, where the power of life and death resides, you release life. By speaking you establish the foundations for the spiritual world to usher in physical, visible changes to your environment. How? Jesus' words are spirit and life.

The Bible uses the word, "quicken" or "quickeneth" which means Jesus' words "GIVE LIFE." (See to it that you bare that in mind.) Jesus words are spirit and life. They ACTUALLY possess some sort of tangible substance, His Words actually have energy which sets things into motion.

Now the Words of Jesus are spiritual. The spiritual invisible world is what gives birth to the physical visible world. Anything done in the spiritual world causes an effect in the physical visible world. Hence the law commonly referred to as;

"Cause and Effect..."

Something else I want you to know is that the words "heart" and "spirit" are used interchangeably in scripture. So when I say, "out the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks" I could also say "out the abundance of the spirit the mouth speaks. I said that to say this, (bearing in mind the spirit quickens/gives life or in other words causes effects on the physical world.)

When you speak **out the abundance of your spirit** with your tongue which has the power of life and death in it. You have caused something to happen in the spirit world which will cause a physical effect. When you release words out of your mouth, speaking to something like Jesus spoke to the fig tree, you are speaking to the very root of the situation. The cause will take effect from the root and have an effect on the rest of the issue.

ALL physical effects (or fruit as the Bible calls it) have a spiritual root/cause, that brought about the physical effect. Faith is THE spiritual force which causes physical effects, "...faith IS the **substance OF THINGS... the evidence OF THINGS** (not seen)... Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word (of God)... things which are seen were not made of things which do **appear.**" (Hebrews 11:1,3)

YOUR words of life spoken from God's Word (IN FAITH) release power on the root cause. They do not change the fruit effect first, but the root, then the fruit. The blessing of the Lord maketh rich and adds no sorrow with it, because the blessing is spiritual and will fix a situation by transforming the **ENTIRE** situation. If you only dealt with things on the level of the fruit, picking off the bad fruit, you will continue producing bad fruit... Unless the spiritual root of the problem is resolved, the same problems will occur.

The blessing of the Lord makes rich and adds **NO** SORROW. Any plant the father has not planted will be ROOTED out. When you deal with things at the root level, the **WHOLE** situation is resolved.

Now when out the abundance of your spirit, you speak spiritual words of life, you are dealing with the situation at its root directly. Now the fruit produced will be as

good as the root you changed. Here's the point I want to make, it may take a while for the goodness, from the root to actually penetrate the entire plant and bear good fruit. I repeat **this process may take a while.**

MY NOTES

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This is why we walk BY FAITH and NOT by sight. For a while it may not LOOK like nothing is happening. "... it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak... While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." (2Corinthians4:13,18)

That basically means that what you SEE happening is completely irrelevant and deceptive because by just looking at what you can see, you can't accurately perceive what is actually really happening. This is why the just live BY faith...

"...faith IS the **substance of things... the evidence of things** (not seen)... Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word (of God)... things which are seen were not made of things which do **appear**." (Hebrews11:1,3)

Behind the scenes there is always something God is doing which you can't see, because it's not always happening in front of you. It's happening elsewhere and when it is complete God will connect it to you one way or a thousand others. The key here is not to give up faith. "Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have **done the will of God**, ye might receive the promise." (Hebrews10:35-36)

Revelation19:13 says Jesus is the called, "...The Word of God" if you apply that to Hebrews10:37-38 it reads, "For yet a little while, and he (Jesus "The Word of God") that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him."

We need to make up our mind about something, speak it and just believe it will be and be in ONE mind about it. "...**one mind** and **one mouth** glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans15:6) So don't give up, quitters never win and winners never quit. We ARE winners in truth we are actually more than winners because the Bible says we are "overcomers" and "MORE than conquerors."

We are not moved by what we SEE... **ONLY** by WHAT THE WORD **OF GOD** SAYS. What the devil wants is for you to be focused on what you can see. Why? Because, when you are only focused on what you can see and you don't SEE change, you get discouraged. But that's **ONLY** if you are focused on what you can see. Seeing is not believing, believing is seeing, seeing what you can't see. Knowing you WILL SEE IT. This is what it means to LIVE BY FAITH **IN THE WORD**... It's those who do this who **SEE** the WORD become visible substance.

The Bible says when you sow the WORD of God into your heart. The devil comes IMMEDIATELY to choke the Word. SUBMIT to God and His Word and resist the devil HE WILL FLEE like playground bully when He sees your big brother Jesus and His crew show up on the scene. Satan is a DEFEATED foe.

This is why you must keep yourself constantly immersed in The Word of God. Keep with the scriptures, they will resolve every negative issue in your life. Every time you have an issue come up, you will have a scripture to attack it with. You will just have scriptures running around in your head like a cat chasing a rat in the attic. That rat will be caught and killed without remorse. So will any negative thought against the Word which tries to exalt itself against God.

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When His Word is in abundance in your heart. No dark evil thing can live in it's presence. Just as dark can not exist where light is present. We are the "children OF light."

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MY NOTES

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As a man thinks in His heart so IS he, out the abundance of your heart your mouth speaks. Your mouth is a good gage to tell what is in abundance within the secret chambers of your heart. In other words you can tell what's in your heart by what comes out your mouth...

For example, when a circumstance contrary to what The Word of God says is so, comes up and your NATURAL response without even thinking is to immediately speak the Word of God, that's when you know the Word of God is in abundance in your heart. If you agree with the circumstance and speak words of worry, then that is what is in abundance in your heart. Your mouth will let you know what you are thinking and as you think in your heart so will you be.

Whatever is in your heart, is what you will speak... You speak either life or death, blessing or cursing God says choose life, so that you and your seed may live (Deuteronomy30:19). If ALL you speak is life and blessing, then that is what is in abundance in your heart; And get this *out of your heart flow the issues of your life* (Proverbs4:23). **What you speak with the power of life in your tongue, you will have, manifested in your life.** Proverbs18:20 says, "A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit **of his** mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled."

Now I want you to notice something there, "A man's belly shall be satisfied WITH the fruit OF **HIS** mouth..." God has spoken all these wonderful promises to you. Here's the thing a man's belly is satisfied with the fruit of HIS own mouth. Although God has said things, if you want to experience them. His Word **MUST** be spoken by YOUR MOUTH. The fruit you see in your life now, is the fruit of your mouth. Speak God's Word and His Word will bear fruit in your life.

What I can see in your life is a result of the words you spoke. Therefore I can tell what was in your heart a while back when you spoke those things. Your environment around you, is simply a manifested delay of what was in your heart in the past. You literally have the power, in your mouth to shape your future, the way you want it to be, if you want your life to change, change the words you speak **RIGHT** this moment and choose to speak life and blessing only! In the future you will **SEE** the fruit of the words you speak now. In the future your environment will display a delayed portrait of what you say today.

The Word says, "Ye shall **know them by** (their **fruits**)" (Matthew7:16).

"...Jesus said, "Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned..." (Matthew12:36-37)

"...Closely connected with Christ's warning in regard to the sin against the Holy Spirit is a warning against idle and evil words. The words are an indication of that which is in the heart. "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh." But the words are more than an indication of character; they have power to react on the character. Men are influenced by their own words. ...It is dangerous to utter a word of doubt, dangerous to question and criticize divine light. The habit of careless and irreverent criticism reacts upon the character, in fostering irreverence and unbelief... (The Desire of Ages p323) I'll go into this more later on...

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You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

The only words that will have any power to change anything in your life, are those spoken in faith or fear. Basically in order for any word you speak to come to pass it must be **firmly believed**, that what you are saying will happen. Now assuming you choose to speak words of life and blessing. You have to genuinely believe the Words you say, they must be abundant in your heart. They must be spoken **in faith**.

Now **every** man has been dealt the measure of faith (Romans12:3) and it is developed by hearing and hearing the word of God (Romans10:17). You need faith because "...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a **rewarder** of them that diligently seek him." (Hebrews11:6)

If you include the definition of faith in this text it really makes your understanding fruitful. It reads like this, "without (faith... the **substance of things** hoped for, the evidence of things not seen) it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God **must believe** that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

You must be diligent in your hearing of The Word, God rewards diligence and you must, "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."

"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success" (Joshua1:8).

As I mentioned before the things which are seen in the physical were made of things which are not seen. God's Words are not seen, they are spirit and they quicken which means they give life. *(God's Words which are spirit and give life ...spoken in faith, were the things NOT SEEN which were the substances responsible for creating the visible world we now live in.)*

Jesus said, "It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life" (John6:63). "It is the spirit that gives life; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life."

"When he made a decree for the rain, and a way for the lightning of the thunder: Then did he see it..." (Job28:26-27)

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God... And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth." (John1:1,14)

"The sower soweth the word..."

the word is sown...*when they have heard...*

the word...was sown **(in) their hearts...**

And these are they which are sown on **good** ground; such as hear the word, AND receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred" (Mark4:14,15,20).

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If you diligently keep the Word of God in your heart, the issues which come out it will be in your life! If there is nothing in your heart but the word of God then nothing will be produced other than His Word. As a man thinks in His Heart so IS he. The more word you have received in you the better the harvest of fruit, from the word-seed your heart will yield.

So What is it that is Required of You to See What YOU Say Happen?

B-E-L-I-E-V-E

Believe... You have been given enough reason to do so. Jesus said, "He that **believeth** on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water" (John7:38). "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that **believeth** on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John14:12).

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"... the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith. And the Lord said, **If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.**" (Luke17:5-6) Did you just hear what Jesus said?

You know from Romans12:3, "God **has** dealt to EVERY man the measure of faith." Therefore you **have** the measure of faith, now let's just say the measure God dealt you was the size of a grain of mustard seed (in other words a very small measure) According to Jesus that measure of faith is sufficient enough for you to **say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey YOU.**

You **already** have enough faith; to say a word to something and whatever you tell it to do it **SHOULD** obey you.

Now what do you need to do, in order for you to decree a thing and have it obey you? You must believe what you say **in your heart**, Jesus said, "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, **but shall believe** that **those things** WHICH (HE) SAITH shall come to pass; *he shall have* (whatsoever) **he** saith" (Mark11:23).

Jesus Himself did it and He told us we could do it. He also specifically said, the things that He does **shall we do** and greater things than these. *(I'm not saying this... Jesus said this,)* Jesus is not a liar. He came that we might have life more abundantly. He said, "He that **believeth** on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John14:12).

It's right there is plain English black and white. He that **believes** Jesus shall do these things. Jesus said it is so, what other proof do you need? We believe our doctors and authority figures, we believe pastors, well believe Jesus. His words carry more weight than anyone's, His words are spirit and they give life. And if His words were used to say, that when you say something and believe it, it will happen, then you rest assured, when you say something it will happen. **Not because you said it, but because He has given your words empowerment by making that statement.**

So whenever you say something and believe it, it will happen. It has to happen it has no choice. This has been decreed by the King of the universe who possesses all power, which was given to Him. The One who created the universe in which we live. If His Words were powerful enough to create the universe, then His words are powerful enough to empower your words to make things happen. He said to us, **"behold I have given you power."**

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If you want the Word of God YOU speak to happen. You have to speak it out of the abundance of your heart. In order for the Word to be in abundance when being **spoken out** of your heart, you have to **HAVE it in** your heart.

Jesus said, "If ye abide in me, and **MY words** abide in you, YE shall ask what **YE WILL**, and it SHALL BE DONE unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit..." (John15:8).

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"A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh" (Luke6:45).

Make sure the Words in the treasure of your heart are Christ's. The Only words you speak which produce fruit are the ones you speak from the abundance of your heart. Whether they are evil or good. "Death **and** life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof" (Proverbs18:21).

MY NOTES

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Whatever words you are speaking whether death or life you will eat the fruit your words produce.

To speak a good thing from the Word **AND SEE IT Happen**, it must first be deposited, written in your heart. One of the ways to get the Word written in you, is to speak it in with your mouth. When that Word/Seed has firmly established its roots within the soil of your heart (in abundance).

Eventually when you speak that word, it won't just be deposited in your heart; but because it's roots have been established, it will actually produce fruit in the physical world. In other words because you now speak The Word out from the abundance of your heart it shall come to pass. And it shall come to pass, because you really believe it.

Here is God's Word confirming what I have said. According to Psalm45:1 & Psalm3:3, you can write the Word on your heart, by using your tongue which is the pen you write it with. See for yourself check it out!!! Psalm3:3 says, "Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart"

"...ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ... written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart" (2Corinthians3:3).

Your mouth is one of the gateways to the heart. When you speak a word from The Word you make a deposit in your heart. Psalm 45:1 says, "My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things which I have made... my tongue is the pen of a ready writer."

Once the word IS written on your heart, you have the Word **in** your heart, in abundance. This is when... your tongue becomes a powerful weapon, "Death and life are **in the power of the tongue**: and they that love it **shall eat the fruit thereof**" (Proverbs18:21). **The words of YOUR mouth from the abundance of your heart have authority over things and circumstances.** "A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled" (Proverbs18:20).

I want you to pay close attention to the following statement. As far as YOU are concerned, it is more powerful for YOU to speak the Word over your life, than it is for me or anybody else to speak over it; because what **you** believe, think and speak takes precedence over what anyone else can do for you or to you.

Even some words God spoke will have no power in your life as far as YOU are concerned UNTIL you believe them and speak them. "...we... believe, and therefore speak" (2Corinthians4:13). You see God, "is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, *according to the power that worketh in us*" (Ephesians3:20).

"...according to (your) faith be it unto you" (Matthew9:29). As powerful as Jesus is He couldn't heal people because of their unbelief read Matthew13:58, "...he did not many mighty works... because of **their** unbelief." Your words carry the most weight over your life than anyone else's.

If you want to get results from the Word, don't rely on me or anybody else to speak it into your life! Speak it to yourself, you carry the power, within you (a

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believing heart and a tongue) that's all you need. I can't nor can God over ride your faith, it will BE according to you.

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REMEMBER that this is a process, it may take a while to get The Word into your heart. So don't be discouraged when you decree something and it doesn't happen straight away. Although you want the Words you speak, to produce something outwardly, understand that to begin with a lot of the Words you are speaking will be simply producing something **in your heart FIRST**. When something substantial is established in your heart, then when you speak and decree a thing it shall come to pass.

Words you speak which defy natural laws will be overridden by the spiritual energy of God's Word (John6:63) that YOU speak!!! Just like when a airplane overrides The Law of Gravity with the law which supersedes it, called "The Law of Lift." Whatever Gravity says, doesn't matter when the Law of Lift comes on the scene. Gravity says the weight of an airplane is heavier than the matter of air, therefore it can not stay in the air. But the Law of Lift says, "Gravity bow down, I'm overriding you."

Gravity can not be stopped, but it can be overcome. We who are born of God are overcomers and have overcome the world and the laws in it. "For whatsoever is born of God **overcometh the world**: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith" (1John5:4).

So you see, your faith in what you speak overcomes the World. "...be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may **prove** what is that good, and acceptable, and **perfect**, will of God" (Romans12:2).

SUPER-natural laws override natural laws. God's Word is SUPER-natural. When you speak SUPER-natural words over natural circumstances & things, the SUPER-natural words SUPERCEDE the natural things and circumstances.

There is a higher SUPER-natural law residing over every natural circumstance in your life that is not in the Will of God. So find The Word that SUPERCEDES your circumstances be it finance, health, love, whatever. Faith itself is a law (Romans3:27) a SUPER-natural law, which when applied with the Word overrides the World.

Speaking The Word is what has power, life and death is in the power of the faith speaking tongue.

Jesus said, "**And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask **any** thing in my name, I will do it**" (John14:13:14). Not some things, ANY thing WHATSOEVER it may be Jesus has PROMISED He will do it!

"Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me" (Isaiah45:11). WOOOOOOOOOW

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"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success." (Joshua1:8)

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Once you have prayed or spoken the word. Speak only words you mean and want to come to pass, don't speak anything contrary to it. Make sure your words are consistently in line with the Word.

"A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit" (Proverbs15:4). Speak Words of Life and Blessing "...I have set before you **life** and death, **blessing** and cursing: therefore **choose life**, that both thou and thy seed may live" (Deuteronomy30:19).

MY NOTES

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"A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof" (Proverbs18:20-21).

"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee" (Proverbs4:23-24).

"Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth" (Proverbs6:2).

Blessing and curses or life and death coming out same mouth ought not be happening... [Watch Your Words...](#)

"For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a **perfect man**, and able also to bridle the whole body.

Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body. Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell...

Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God...

Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh.

[Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom...](#)

But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace" (James3:2-6, 9, 12-13, 17-18).

Consistency in speak good words is the key. "Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things" (Phillipians4:8).

The Psalmist wrote, "Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight..." (Psalm19:14).

We and our words must be, "in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. A double minded man is unstable in all his ways" (James1:6-8).

Ye Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

MY NOTES

(From What God Impresses On My Heart)

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You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

In being double minded we offend God as he can't be pleased without faith, faith is *fully persuaded* NOT double minded. If you are not FULLY persuaded you offend God and off-end your faith, with your double mind "For in **many** things we offend all. If any **man** offend not in word, the same is a **perfect man...**" (James3:2).

Keep Your Word Consistently... "...whoever keeps His word, *truly* the **love of God** IS **perfected in him...**" (1John2:5). If our love is perfect so is our faith because *Faith works BY love.*

Since we can not expect to receive anything of the Lord with a double mind the only other available option is to be of;

"ONE Mind..."

"But he is in **one mind**, and who can turn him? and what his soul desireth, even that he doeth" (Job23:13).

A double minded man is not a man in faith and a man not in faith can not please God. "...ye may with **one mind** and **one mouth** glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans15:6).

"...Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of **one mind**, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you" (2Corinthians13:11).

"...stand fast in **one spirit**, with **one mind** striving together for the faith of the gospel" (Philippians1:27).

"Fulfil ye my joy...being... of **one mind**" (Philippians2:3).

Watch What You Observe and Allow to Speak into Your Life...

Refrain from listening to or watching anything which is contrary to the Word you believe. What you pay attention to most and have speaking to you the most is what you will believe, so make sure you, listen to and watch the RIGHT things. "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the **issues of life**" (Proverbs4:23).

"A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the **abundance of the heart** his **mouth** speaketh" (Luke6:45).

No Matter What You Feel the Circumstances Say, Don't Give Your Power to Them by Agreeing with them and Speaking about them as if they have authority...

They only have authority, **if** YOU grant them that power with YOUR words. You are the one in control, what you manifest will be according to your faith.

So even if you feel tempted to speak the concerns you have which are contrary to what The Word says; do your best with the power of Christ which strengthens you to refrain. Don't utter every and any thought that comes to your mind. So many people say, "Well I just speak what I feel, I'm just being real." According to God that is unwise...

"In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips is wise" (Proverbs10:19).

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"A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul"
(Proverbs18:7).

"The wicked is snared by the transgression of his lips: but the just shall come out of trouble. A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him... There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is health. The lip of truth shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment."
(Proverbs12:13-14,18-19)

(I'm going to read the same passage and put the cross references in) "The wicked is ENSNARED by the transgression of his lips: but the just shall come out of trouble. A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him... There is ONE WHO speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise promotes health. The TRUTHFUL LIP shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment."

The truth isn't always in the appearance OF THINGS we see. So therefore the truthful lip of a person who lives by faith, will talk of things which can not be seen and it shall be established for ever. But the person whose mouth agrees only with what they can see is only speaking facts. Facts can change and facts don't always line up with truth.

So when we think we are being real saying what we feel. We are actually just speaking facts which are subject to change, because they are subject to truth. Truth changes facts, facts don't have the capability to change truth. The truth is constant whether it can be seen or not.

"For we walk by faith, not by sight" (2Corinthians5:7). "...we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; (a lying tongue is but for a moment) but the things which are not seen are eternal" (2Corinthians4:18). "The TRUTHFUL LIP shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment." Speak the truth, even if it can not be seen. This is wise and the words of your truthful lips, shall be established forever.

"A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards."
(Proverbs29:11) (The cross reference says) "A fool uttereth all his mind (vents his feelings): but a wise man HOLDS IT BACK..."

"The words of wise men are heard in quiet more than the cry of him that ruleth among fools." (Ecclesiastes9:17) (cross reference) "The words of wise men SPOKEN QUIETLY SHOULD BE HEARD RATHER THAN THE SHOUT."
"When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things." (1Corinthians13:11)

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"If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen" (1Peter4:11-13).

You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

The scripture says this, "The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master" (Luke6:40).

MY NOTES

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Ye Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

"Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways. When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the humble person. He shall deliver the island of the innocent: and it is delivered by the pureness of thine hands."
(Job22:28-30)

"God... calleth those (things which be **not**) as though they were." (Romans4:17)
Now this is interesting because, Ephesians5:1 says, "Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children" the word "followers" in the original Greek is, "mimic" or "imitate". So in Greek it would read "Be ye therefore be imitators of God as dear children."

"... it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak... While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal" (2Corinthians4:13,18).

"If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability **which God giveth**: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen" (1Peter4:11-13).

Jesus said, "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: **for without me ye can do nothing.**

If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, YE shall ask what YE WILL, and it SHALL BE DONE unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit..." (John15:1-8).
God is glorified when the words we speak bare MUCH fruit... (Because when we abide in Christ) His Words that are in us, bear fruit.

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Now We are living by faith (Hebrews10:38). Therefore we do not allow our circumstances to dictate to us, who we are, what we can do or what we can have. We dictate what happens to our circumstances, by our words thoughts, faith and actions. (2Corinthians4:13)

Therefore We Can Speak God's Words Boldly and (EXPECT) to SEE things happen, "...Be not afraid, ONLY believe" (Mark5:36). The righteous are never forsaken (Psalm37:25).

God is a God, "That **confirmeth** the word of his servant..." (Isaiah44:26)
If you look at some of the definitions of the word "confirm" it adds more to your understanding. God establishes the word of His servant,
God acknowledges with definite assurance the word of His Servant.
God makes valid the Word of His servant.

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Ye Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

GOD will establish and make valid with definite assurance the words YOU speak, that is power-FULL. If God confirms what you say it is as GOOD as God Himself saying what you said. And look what happens when God says something.

"So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it" (Isaiah55:11). "Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it" (Jeremiah1:12).

(cross reference) "Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I AM WATCHING OVER my word to perform it." Notice what God said, He said I am watching over **MY** WORD. Speak **HIS** Word which HE IS WATCHING over. He watches HIS Word spoken from your lips and goes to perform it. Once He confirms your word speaking HIS Word, IT'S His word and He will hasten to perform His Word.

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise..." (2Peter3:9)

When All You See Is Negativity Don't Speak Negativity, You'll Create More of The Same... SPEAK THE WORD ONLY you will create what the Word says in your life. Only speak, what God says, which you want. Don't say I don't have enough money to pay this bill. Pray according to His Word BELIEVING He will do it. Jesus promised whatsoever you desire when you pray you will have it. If you ask in His name HE WILL do it. When you pray according to the Word you HAVE the petitions you desired of Him. When you ended your prayer you said, "In Jesus name Amen." What you really said was, "IN Jesus name... So Be It..." It is done.

So... AFTER you have prayed... From that point on, you believe you have received. So speak about it as if you have it. With thanksgiving, you made your request to God, because you KNEW He would do it. Speak and act as though it is done. God calls things that be not, as though they were and as you are meant to be mimicking God and be as your master, you should call things that be not as though they are. We believe and therefore we speak and we live by faith, ONLY speaking the Word, no matter what we SEE.

So once you have prayed according to the Word about paying a bill. From now on your words must agree with God's Word, "El-Shaddai (My God who is sufficient for the needs of His people) has supplied ALL my need according to His Riches in glory."

Let the poor SAY, "I AM Rich..."

Let the ill SAY, "I AM Whole..."

"There is ONE WHO speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise promotes health" (Proverbs12:18).

As challenging as it maybe, to just say how you feel and let your words line up with what is around you. Don't!!! "A fool uttereth all his mind (vents his feelings): but a wise man HOLDS IT BACK..." (Proverbs29:11) This is why you need ONE mind to glorify God with.

Jesus promised, "And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it" (John14:13-14)." If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you" (John15:7).

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"Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." (Mark11:24)

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You Shall Decree a Thing And It SHALL Come To Pass

Ok So WHAT EXACTLY IS THIS IS ALL FOR???

What is the use in decreeing a thing so it will come to pass. What is the ultimate purpose for which God intended it, why have we been given this power?

Job22:28-30 sums up the answer to this question better than any words I can come up with, *"Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways. When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the humble person. He shall deliver the island of the innocent: and it is delivered by the pureness of thine hands."*

Go with me if you will to, 1Corinthians14:1,3 (cross reference used). "Follow after LOVE, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy... he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort."

Let's break this text down, I found a definition of the word "prophesy" it said, *"to reveal the will or message of God."* "If **any** man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen." (1Peter4:11-13)

The word "edification" was used also, its taken from the word "edify" which means, *"to inform, instruct, or benefit, morally or spiritually in order to enlighten, build up, or strengthen a person."*

The word "exhortation" was used too, it's taken from the word "exhort," it is the *ability to help others reach their full potential by means of encouraging, challenging, comforting, and guiding them by motivating them to take action; achieving inward transformation/spiritual fulfillment and outward manifestation of godly fruit in their lives."*

Exhortation comes from the same Greek word translated "Helper," "Counselor" and "Comforter" in John16:7. The gift of exhortation is "the ability to bring encouragement, to help others see the relevance of Scripture, to give insightful counsel, to motivate, to comfort, and to offer hope that **prompts action**. We see an example in Paul's 1 letter to the Thessalonians, in which he exhorts Christians to **do** a wide range of things: "Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all" (1Thessalonians 5:14).

Exhorters exhort Christians to warn, comfort, uphold, to be patient. Exhortation is used to motivate people towards achieving inward transformation/spiritual fulfillment and outward manifestation of godly fruit in their lives. **Transformation is the goal of exhortation:** to see the person growing more in their spiritual life and becoming more like Christ.

So let's put that all together with the meanings of the words to make sense of 1Corinthians14:1,3 and understand what God wants us to decree and why, "Follow after LOVE, and desire spiritual gifts, but **rather** that ye may (reveal the will or message of God) ... he that (reveals the will or message of God) speaketh unto men in order to (to inform, instruct, or benefit, morally or spiritually in order to enlighten, build up, or strengthen a person), and (help others reach their full potential by means of encouraging, challenging, comforting, and guiding them by motivating them to take action, achieving inward transformation/spiritual

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fulfillment and outward manifestation of godly fruit in their lives) and comfort them."

The is what the master did, "The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master" (Luke6:40). "As He is in this world so are WE..." (1John4:17)
