And now at His first appearance to the disciples after His resurrection, the Saviour addressed them with the blessed words, "Peace be unto you." Jesus is ever ready to speak peace to souls that are burdened with doubts and fears. He waits for us to open the door of the heart to Him, and say, Abide with us. He says, "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me." Rev. 3:20." (Desire of Ages p803-804)

"And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Phillipians4:7

"And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever." Isaiah32:17

As Christ's followers we are sent to the world with the message of peace. If we don't even have peace ourselves, then how are the worldly going to believe, when there is no evidence of this peace in our own lives?

"Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God." Matt5:9

The spirit of peace in us is our evidence of our connection with God. We should have an undeniable difference with our very presence which is irresistible accompanied with loviness of character, which reveals our mark to the world the fact that we **are** children of God.

Jesus said the People of this world will be able to tell who we are by our character of love (which has peace with it)

We can have peace because we TRUST...

"Therefore being justified **by faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" Romans5:1

Now Jesus Is The Word (Revelation19:13) Therefore...

The Bible IS Jesus... (In WORD Form...)

Jesus not only quoted The Word of God He WAS the quote... In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. Jesus was not only the quoting the quotation, He was what was inside the quotation marks! He was the quote! He was the Word and so when He quoted He wasn't quoting something that

was outside of Himself, He was actually the very thing He was quoting. In being a testimony we are to not only share what God has done but also we are to be consistent in showing others we are examples of the Word itself, The Word is Jesus we are to be examples of Him!

Faith cometh by hearing and hearing By the Word of God, the scriptures are the great agencies, in the transformation of the Character your character is transformed by what is written. The Holy Spirit comes to convict of sin and the faith that springs up in the heart works by love to Christ conforming us in body mind and spirit to His own image. Our Characters are to be transformed into the image of God's son... And The image of God's Son, is the image OF the Word. So what does that mean? ***Jesus became Word, The word became flesh, so that the flesh could become the Word... So the flesh could become as Jesus!*** We are to become the quote, we are to be what we are quoting!

Since Jesus left in flesh, His presence on earth is now in Word form again ("I will be with you always") and when we read it and become it, The Word becomes flesh! It is our responsibility to make Christ which is in word form to become flesh again.

The Word is also referred to as seed! What do orange seeds produce? Oranges! What does Word seed produce? Word! We are to plant The Word seed in our heart and produce the Word, become the Word! We were "born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever." 1Peter1:23

Jesus was the seed that had to die and except a seed die and be planted it won't yield a harvest! Jesus IS Word except it be planted in our hearts, WE cannot become the Word! *Recognise that your work in drawing close to be imbued with His power and character is a progressive continuous process...* Christ's desires for you to understand that ONLY by receiving and appropriating truth can you're ruined nature be reconstructed.

Words alone cannot tell it. Let it be reflected in the character and manifested in the life. Christ is sitting for His portrait in every disciple. Every one God has predestinated to be "conformed to the image of His Son." Rom. 8:29. "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God." Romans8:19 In every one Christ's long-suffering love, His holiness, meekness, mercy, and truth are to be manifested to the world. (Desire of Ages 872)

I find it strange that we will take people who have told lies at their word. Yet we won't take The Word of The ONE who has never lied and finds it impossible to lie. We will take the word of people who have lied without even questioning it.

We trust what authority figures tell us. We act on what they say, but when it comes to acting on what GOD says THE ONE **TRUE** AUTHORITY... all of a sudden we start questioning things, we want proof, we want a sign!

The reason we want proof is because we have not allowed our worldly flesh and carnal natures to be transformed by the truth of God's Word...

*"...be not conformed to **this world**: but be ye transformed **by the renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."*
Romans12:2

How can you be transformed to have trust in God's Word??? Find God's Word for your situation and MEDITATE it... (That means instead of worrying about the situation keep pondering what God's Word PROMISES in your situation...)

"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success." Joshua1:8

Eventually you will be fully persuaded, that what God promised He is also ABLE to perform (Romans4:21).

You will LIVE by Faith... (In What God Has SAID)

And you will, "...look **not** at the things (or situations) which are seen, but at the things which are not seen (i.e. God's Word): for the things (or situations) which are seen are temporal; but God's Word and the things which are not seen are eternal."
2Corinthians4:18

You will learn to fight good fight of faith, what does it mean to do that? Jesus did this, in every situation, He responded to it with The Written Word. This is why it is so important to know scripture, because, Holy Spirit will bring them to your remembrance (John14:26).

So you can say to any given situation... Say hello to my little friend OR BIG friend in this case... The scripture is Jesus in WORD form, it's also a weapon, you can think of The Bible as a gun and every Word in it is a bullet, and every text is a clip!

And all you have to do to fight the GOOD fight of faith is, aim and FIRE!!! (In other words, speak the Word of God to EVERY doubtful thought, situation or circumstance that presents itself to you!)

So for example Satan says, "God won't do XYZ for you... In fact ABC is going to happen, OK Yeah He did it for so and so but He ain't gonna do it for you!"

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You submit to God and His Word and you say whatever The Word you're standing on says, "Say Hello to my friend! Acts10:34, "...God is no respecter of persons" Don't let me get Romans10:12 oh you asked for it now! "For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him."

And let me tell you something else Isaiah54:17 "No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn."

What did you just do??? By the power given you by none other than Jesus, you just casted down the imagination and high thing, that tried to exalt itself above God and His Word.

That's How you FIGHT the GOOD fight of faith! It's a good fight cos YOU win!
When have you ever had a good fight you didn't win? And you can't help but win, because the battle is the Lord's and He has told us, He had OVERCOME the World!

The Practical Thing To...

"Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the tablet of thine heart:" Proverbs 3:3

One thing I recommend for you to do, is to keep a diary of every time you are in a situation, where God worked something out for you, BIG and little...

In every situation, I highly recommend you pray and find God's Word to stand on... In fact if you go to: www.GodAnswersYes.com and get the "Prayer Model" ebook... You will find the appendix has The Word of God for different situations, which you can stand on and TRUST God will honour!

Get a note pad or whatever you fancy as your diary and write down times you remember in times passed, where God took good care of you, honouring His Word which you were trusting in... and from NOW on write down, EVERY experience, where He does this...

If you weren't standing on His Word in times passed and God still worked something out for you, praise God anyway! And begin trusting in His Word for your situations from now on!

Then the next time a tricky or unfavourable situation shows up, look where He honoured His word to you before. If He did it once before KNOW that He will do it again. **"In God there is no shadow of turning or any variableness"** James1:17

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Kept BY The Word...

*"Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. ...his righteousness endureth for ever. ...his heart **is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid...**" Psalm 112:1,3 7-8*

"...he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat" Proverbs 28:25

As Christ's earthly ministry drew to a close, and He realized that He must soon leave His disciples to carry on the work without His personal supervision, He sought to encourage them and to prepare them for the future. He did not deceive them with false hopes. As an open book He read what was to be. He knew He was about to be separated from them, to leave them as sheep among wolves. He knew that they would suffer persecution, that they would be cast out of the synagogues, and would be thrown into prison. He knew that for witnessing to Him as the Messiah, some of them would suffer death. And something of this He told them. **In speaking of their future, He was plain and definite, that in their coming trial they might remember His words** and be strengthened to believe in Him.

"These things I have spoken unto you," He said, "that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." John 16:33. Christ did not fail, neither was He discouraged; and the disciples were to show a faith of the same enduring nature. They were to work as He had worked, depending on Him for strength. Though their way would be obstructed by apparent impossibilities, **yet by His grace they were to go forward, despairing of nothing and hoping for everything.**

"After the Saviour's ascension, the sense of the divine presence, full of love and light, was still with them. It was a personal presence. Jesus, the Saviour, who had walked and talked and prayed with them, who had spoken hope and comfort to their hearts, had, while the message of peace was upon His lips, been taken from them into heaven. As the chariot of angels received Him, His words had come to them, **"Lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end."** Matthew 28:20. He had ascended to heaven in the form of humanity. They knew that He was before the throne of God, their Friend and Saviour still; that His sympathies were unchanged; that He would forever be identified with suffering humanity. They knew that He was presenting before God the merit of His blood, showing His wounded hands and feet as a remembrance of the price He had paid for His redeemed ones; and this thought strengthened them to endure reproach for His sake. **Their union with Him was stronger now than when He was with them in person.**" (The Acts of the Apostles p65)

I'm here to tell you the truth... You ARE going to have challenges... if I was to say ok you're Christian and God won't permit hard times to come your way! I would be lying!

Hard times will come God told us that and you know what according to scripture it's not getting better, it's gonna get worse! When Paul prayed He didn't ask God to take trouble away from Him! He asked Him for the grace to go THROUGH it! Well if you're going through something, then one can assume that you're going to come out the other side! Jesus said, in this world you will have tribulation... **BUT be of GOOD Cheer!**

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"My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience." James1:2-3.

Jesus speaking to Peter said, "...Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren." Luke22:31-32

Do you remember the story, when Satan wanted to trouble Job? You know what I find interesting... **He had to ASK God for permission to touch Job!!!** "*Err God, I was wondering is it OK if I give Job a hard time!*" He had to ask God before He could even touch Job. Which tells me, that although Satan is powerful, he is still subject to the boundaries God set!

This reminds me God is STILL sovereign! And also that when you are going through something He knows about it, Jesus said to Peter, "*Satan has desired you...*" Satan had obtain permission! And there are times God allows it, He sees it as an opportunity for the trying of your faith to develop your faith, your character and you! "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience." James1:2-3. But the good thing is that God is merciful and still limits Satan assaults to the extent, that you can take. (1Corinthians10:13)

That's comforting to KNOW! Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." John14:27

"These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation... ...they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake... And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. ...but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." (John16:33 & Luke21:12,16)

"What was the strength of those who in the past have suffered persecution for Christ's sake? It was union with God, union with the Holy Spirit, union with Christ... Never is the tempest-tried soul more dearly loved by His Saviour than when he is suffering reproach for the truth's sake. "I will love him," Christ said, "and will manifest Myself to him." John 14:21. (*Christ is The Word, so His Word will manifest itself to you...*)

When for the truth's sake the believer stands at the bar of earthly tribunals, Christ stands by his side. When he is confined within prison walls, Christ manifests Himself to him and cheers his heart with His love. When he suffers death for Christ's sake, the Saviour says to him, They may kill the body, but they cannot hurt the soul. "Be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness." John 16:33; Isaiah 41:10." (The Acts of the Apostles p85-86)

God promised you, that He will restrict the degree to which Satan can tempt you to doubt His Word to the level you can handle! The promise comes to mind, "*Many are*

the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them ALL." (Psalm 34:19) So why fret anything!

So when you go through trying times REALISE this and rejoice!!! I said rejoice!

Here is another reason to rejoice Jesus said, "But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not:" Luke 22:32 (**JESUS**) Prayed FOR you!!! Jesus who overcame, the WORLD! Peace be still Jesus, Jesus who walked on water! Jesus who speaks to anything and it must obey! Yeah that Jesus!!! HE said, I have prayed for you! And my Bible tells me, that Jesus is righteous and that, "...The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." James 5:16.

If our prayers avail much, how much MORE does Jesus' prayer avail! I have some friends who can pray and I mean pray up a storm! But When Jesus says I have prayed FOR YOU!!! That gives me reason to get excited! (And by the way, if you're interested to know what Jesus prayed for you READ John 17)

You know when I said, things will get worse! Guess what they will! Daniel 12:1 says, "And at that time shall **Michael** stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: *and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.*"

Trust 100% & Be Comforted...

"He that loveth Me shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself to him." Jesus encourages us with the promise that in every trial He will be with us. That promise has lost none of its force. The Lord knows all about His faithful servants who for His sake are lying in prison or who are banished to lonely islands. He comforts them with His own presence. When for the truth's sake the believer stands at the bar of unrighteous tribunals, Christ stands by his side. All the reproaches that fall upon him, fall upon Christ. Christ is condemned over again in the person of His disciple. When one is incarcerated in prison walls, Christ ravishes the heart with His love. When one suffers death for His sake, Christ says, "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, . . . and have the keys of hell and of death." Rev. 1:18. The life that is sacrificed for Me is preserved unto eternal glory.

At all times and in all places, in all sorrows and in all afflictions, when the outlook seems dark and the future perplexing, and we feel helpless and alone, the Comforter will be sent in answer to the prayer **of faith**. Circumstances may separate us from every earthly friend; but no circumstance, no distance, can separate us from the heavenly Comforter. Wherever we are, wherever we may go, He is always at our right hand to support, sustain, uphold, and cheer.

When in doubt take a moment to look at nature and observe how God is faithful to take care of us! The world is round when have we ever fallen off this planet? The world goes around the sun at a ridiculous speed and spins, yet we somehow we

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don't fly off with the speed at which it spins! Look how the sun stays up in the sky and keeps you warm! Look how God takes care of us watering the earth as His garden!

Since He did all that... How much more is He capable to take care of your little trivial matters? You worry about Him being able to supply enough to pay your little bills when He is the one that created the universe, **with His Word where everything in nature is just as subject to Him as when He first spoke it!** And it is the same Word from the same lips which says, "I SHALL supply **all** your needs, according to MY riches in glory."

People need to recognize God as the Creator of the universe, One who commands **and executes** all things. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made." John1:1, 14, 3 "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God..." Hebrews11:3

God is not a man that He should lie, in Him there is no variableness, He hastens His Word to perform it! His Word never returns to Him void! It prospers in EVERY thing He sends it! The same Words He used to create the Universe and control how it operates, still have the same power today, as you can see... He gave YOU HIS same words Word to bank on! Why be afraid!?!

Seek first the Kingdom, all the things you need will be ADDED! That promise has power, it was spoken from the same mouth which declared let there be light! We still have that light warming our earth to this day! So God still supplies all our needs to this day!

I'd like to share with you some Words from a book called, (Desire of Ages p807-808)

Thomas... "...would not see through the eyes of his brethren, or exercise faith which was dependent upon their testimony. He ardently loved his Lord, but he had **allowed** jealousy and unbelief to take possession of his mind and heart." "Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe."

Jesus turning to Thomas said, "Reach hither thy finger, and behold My hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into My side: and be not faithless, but believing." These words showed that He was acquainted with the thoughts and words of Thomas. The doubting disciple knew that none of his companions had seen Jesus for a week. They could not have told the Master of his unbelief. He recognized the One before him as his Lord. He had no desire for further proof. His heart leaped for joy, and he cast himself at the feet of Jesus crying, "My Lord and my God."

Jesus accepted his acknowledgment, but gently reproved his unbelief: "Thomas, because thou hast seen Me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed." The faith of Thomas would have been more pleasing to Christ if he had been willing to believe upon the testimony of his brethren. (*Likewise we should be willing to believe the testimony of The Word of God*) Should the world now follow the example of Thomas, no one would believe unto salvation; for all who receive Christ must do so through the testimony of others.

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Many who are given to doubt excuse themselves by saying that if they had the evidence which Thomas had from his companions, they would believe. They do not realize that they have not only that evidence (*God's Word which we spoke about earlier*), but much more. Many who, like Thomas, wait for all cause of doubt to be removed, will never realize their desire. They gradually become confirmed in unbelief. Those who educate themselves to look on the dark side, and murmur and complain, know not what they do. They are sowing the seeds of doubt, and they will have a harvest of doubt to reap. **At a time when faith and confidence are most essential, many will thus find themselves powerless to hope and believe.**

In His treatment of Thomas, Jesus gave a lesson for His followers. His example shows how we should treat those whose faith is weak, and who make their doubts prominent. Jesus did not overwhelm Thomas with reproach, nor did He enter into controversy with him. He revealed **Himself** to the doubting one. (He... **IS** The Word according to John1:1-2 & Revelation19:13... So The Word is to be revealed to those doubting... be it us or others) Thomas had been most unreasonable in dictating the conditions of his faith, but Jesus (The Word), by His generous love and consideration, broke down all the barriers.

"In sorrow and affliction, when the outlook seems dark and the future perplexing, and we feel helpless and alone,—these are the times when, in answer to the prayer **of faith**, the Holy Spirit brings comfort to the heart.

It is not a conclusive evidence that a man is a Christian because he manifests spiritual ecstasy under extraordinary circumstances. ...it is an entire surrender of the will to God; **it is living by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God; it is doing the will of our heavenly Father; it is trusting God in trial, in darkness as well as in the light; it is walking by faith and not by sight; it is relying on GOD with unquestioning confidence, and resting in His love.**" (Acts Of The Apostles p51)

"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." Psalm1:1-3

"Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. Surely he shall not be moved for ever... He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. His heart is established, he shall not be afraid" Psalm112:1-2,4,6-8

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Speak The Word of God (ABOUT...) AND (TO...) EVERY SITUATION...

You shall decree a thing and it shall be established... (Job22:28) God is a God who, "...confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers..." Isaiah44:26. He said, "...Concerning works of my hand command ye me" Isaiah45:11. When you speak or **CONFESS** God's Word, and TRUST Him, you give Him permission to get involved in your situation!

The Greek word for confession is "Homo-Logeo", "Homo" means "same" and "Logeo" is to do with Words spoken. So it means to SAY what has BEEN said, we are to SAY what GOD has already said! Or we are to speak the SAME thing God has spoken!

God has commissioned angels to carry out **His** Word, which they hear **you** speak! Psalms103:20 says, "Bless the LORD, ye his **angels**, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening **unto the voice of his word**." Angels carry out God's Word spoken. When YOU speak His Word they move!!! Why because the angels are obedient to Christ and Christ is The Word of God, so when you speak the Word they are under obligation to move... "Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?" Hebrews1:14.

Under God the angels are all-powerful. On one occasion, in obedience to the command of Christ, they slew of the Assyrian army in one night 185,000 men.

God gave YOU His Word, so YOU could tap into His supernatural resources.

When you as His Child open your mouth and speak what God has said, what YOU say, retrieves God's plans and demands they be fulfilled on earth! Jesus said, "And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." Matthew16:19

So when you speak God's Word you obligate Him to do something, some of the powerful words you can ever say is, "**God YOU Promised...**" He'll honour WHATEVER He promised and hasten His Word to perform it, because He esteems His Word above His own Name!!! (Psalm138:2) And knowing this you can have faith and assurance God's Word will prevail in your situation!

The only thing in our world upon which we can rely is the Word of God. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." Matt. 6:33. When we learn the power of His word, we shall not follow the suggestions of Satan in order to obtain food or to save our lives. **Our only questions will be, What is God's command? and what His promise? Knowing these, we shall obey the one, and trust the other.**

FAITH is... KNOWING without knowing HOW!!!

Trust the Words God spoke **will** come to pass! God is not the God of the dead, but of the living." God counts the things that are not as though they were. He sees the end from the beginning, and beholds the result of His work as though it were now accomplished. What needs to ultimately happen is you need to LOOSE confidence in yourself, every time you do you, you tell God, "*I take better care of myself than you, I am my own Lord!*"

Kept BY The Word... (Worry Free)

YES God has given you power and praise God for it but... Rejoice not in the possession of your power and ability, lest you lose sight of your dependence upon God. Be careful lest self-sufficiency come in, and you work in your own strength, rather than in the spirit and strength of your Master. Self is ever ready to take the credit if any measure of success attends the work. Self is flattered and exalted, and the impression is not made upon other minds that God is all and in all. The apostle Paul says, "When I am weak, **then** am I strong." 2 Cor. 12:10.

When we have a realization of our weakness, ***we learn to depend upon a power not inherent***. Nothing can take so strong a hold on the heart as the abiding sense of our responsibility to God.

We are to come in touch with God, then we shall be imbued with His Holy Spirit. While you look higher than yourself, you will have a continual sense of the weakness of humanity. The less you cherish self, the more distinct and full will be your comprehension of the excellence of your Saviour.

The more closely you connect yourself with the source of light and power, the greater light will be shed upon you, and the greater power will be yours to work for God.

The church is built upon Christ/The Word as its foundation; it is to obey Christ/The Word as its head. It is not to depend upon man, or be controlled by man. The Rock of faith is the living presence of Christ in the church. Upon this the weakest may depend, and those who think themselves the strongest will prove to be the weakest, **unless they make Christ their efficiency**. "Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm." The Lord "is the Rock, His work is perfect." "Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him." Jer. 17:5; Deut. 32:4; Ps. 2:12.
